#### AGM 2013-14

The AGM was held on Monday, 30 June 2014 at 14/F., The Chinese Club, 21, Connaught Road, Central, H.K.

#### **Student Ambassadors 2013-14**

#### **EGM**

The School's SMC (School Management Committee) has been renamed as IMC (Incorporated Management Committee). An EGM was held on Monday, 11 August, 2014 to deal with some Special Resolutions in PSA'S M & A (Memorandum of Association of the Association).

#### **IMC Manager Election**

In September 2014, Fr. The function was well attended and proved to be very successful.
