Dear Alumni and Friends,

Since last May, a lot of bonding and fundraising activities have been launched with the support and assistance of the Jesuits, the two Wah Yan Colleges and Past Students' Associations (HK & KLN), Parent-Teacher Association (WYHK), Parents' Association (WYK), our beloved teachers, staff members, young Wahyanites and friends.

To name just a few, the 2nd Live Talk on Home Safety was held on 8 June 2022 featuring Ivan Han, our Social Service Group Chairman and Amos Cheung WYK97, our psychologist. The Talk received over 500 viewership.

The last 2 performances of WY100+ Music Festival were held on 22 and 23 October 2022 at the Grand Theatre, Hong Kong Cultural Centre, receiving a 90%+ occupancy. Together with the first 3 performances held on 4-6 January 2022, the Festival presented a full spectrum of performing arts evolved in the history of Wah Yan. An unprecedented event per se among schools in Hong Kong, the event netted \$1.2 million for continued development of the Schools.

On 28 November 2022, the 3rd Live Talk was launched by Wah Yan Sailors – Mark Chan WYHK89, Jonathan Mok WYK2015 and Oswin Widjaja WYK2J – who shared their experiences in learning how to sail and the benefits for body and soul. These Wahyanites also managed to gather 7 boats and over 50 sailors to take part in the 2nd Alma Mater Race organized by the Hong Kong Royal Yacht Club on 18 December 2022. They not only introduced a new sport to the Schools, but also furthered the

collaborations between pupils, teachers, parents and alumni.

Our “Run for and with Others” happened again in the Hong Kong Marathon held on 12 February 2023. With the generous support of over 20 runners and donors, we netted \$200,000 plus from the run to support sport development in the two Schools.

Looking ahead, we are working with the Schools to launch the next phase of fundraising initiatives in 2023-2025 to gather support for furthering the quality of Jesuit education, e.g. additional NET teachers, STEAM programmes, sports development and other learning experiences. The object is to enable each Wahyanite to bloom in his unique way God has intended. We will continue to launch more meaningful fundraising and bonding initiatives to gather a massive reserve for this purpose. Taking this opportunity, may we sincerely thank you all again for your unflinching backing and please continue your selfless efforts in helping our alma mater achieve new heights.

Chairman's Report 2022-2023 by Nelson Ng ('00)

Dear Wahyanites,

I am very honoured to be elected Chairman for the term 2022-2023 to serve the Wah Yan (Hong Kong) Past Students Association (PSA) and my alma mater.

Over the past year, I was glad to see the gradual return to normalcy from the COVID-19 pandemic, with various social distancing measures relaxed and eventually lifted by phases. To allow alumni and teachers who might not have met each other for a long time to gather together, the PSA and its subsidiaries including the fraternities and interest groups organized a variety of face-to-face events and activities, in particular, the following:-

- The Reunion Dinner was resumed after 3 years of suspension at the school hall for the teachers, alumni (with their graduation years ending with "2") and fresh graduates.
- Wah Yan International Reunion (WYIR) 2022 jointly organized with Wah Yan College, Kowloon Past Students' Association (WYKPSA) was the first ever WYIR conducted in hybrid mode, allowing local Wahyanites to meet face-to-face and those from the overseas to join virtually.
- The Spring Dinner in Metropol Restaurant attended by guests, teachers and alumni from classes with a span of over 60 years.

The mentorship program is one of the core businesses of the PSA. In the past 12 months, we organized a mentor and mentee matching session, a career fair, a job shadowing scheme and a joint interview workshop with Marymount Secondary School. The PSA would like to thank the alumni involved in the mentorship program for sparing their time and work places to provide coaching and shadowing opportunities for the Form 5 students.

As always, the PSA maintains a very close relationship with our alma mater and is prepared to support and make contributions. In July 2022, the PSA donated HK\$200,000 arising from souvenir sales to the Incorporated Management Committee (IMC) of WYCHK. In November 2022, the PSA subsidized

HK\$25,000 for various activities of student and school organizations. In February 2023, a tram tour was organized for the School Principal, Dr Davis Chan, current and retired teachers, as well as the Council Members.

We continue to join hands and work together with our brother association, WYKPSA, through joint alumni activities. In addition to the aforementioned WYIR 2022, the two Wah Yan PSAs organized a joint-association happy hour drinks with Maryknoll Convent School Former Students' Association (MCSFSA) and Marymount Secondary School Alumnae Association (MSSAA) on 3 May 2023.

The Junior Alumni Council (JAC), a subsidiary of the PSA comprised of a group of young and energetic alumni in their twenties of age, organized a bouldering and rock climbing event in January this year. More JAC activities are being arranged specially for the younger generation of alumni.

In this term, we have made a lot of announcements and promotions of events and activities via the PSA's official Facebook and Instagram pages. We have also attracted many new members to follow and like our pages. Time flies and my term of service is going to end soon. Dear Wahyanites,

As the world and our city gradually return to normalcy after three years of the pandemic, I am delighted to share this message with fellow Wahyanites and provide an update on what is happening at our alma mater. Since the government began easing precautionary measures, we have been pleased not only to see the faces of our young gentlemen but also to witness the dynamic interactions among teachers and students on campus. We are also excited to see our gentlemen enjoying various extracurricular events and community outreach programs.

We are thrilled to share that our young gentlemen have received remarkable recognition for their talents. Our college won the boys' overall third runner-up in Hong Kong Inter-School Athletics Division One Competition 2022-23, and our Orienteering Team won a championship in the Hong Kong Inter-school District Sprint Orienteering Championships 2022-23. Our wind band received a gold award in the Joint School Music Association Competition, while our choir received a silver award in both the Joint School Music Association Competition and the Hong Kong Inter-school Choral Festival, just to name a few achievements.

In addition to participating in competitions, our College has resumed our High Table Dinner, which brought together Form 4 and Form 5 student leaders from our college and other schools to connect, build relationships, reflect, and learn together. Our young gentlemen also participated in a community art project, painting a tram on the theme of 'Men for and with others,' which they shared with the community. Our Past Students Association organized a tram tour, which I and other past students and teachers enjoyed thoroughly.

Upcoming events include the Citizenship and Social Development's Mainland Study Tour for our Form 5 students in early May, and a three-day Singapore Leadership Training program for our Form 4 student

leaders in the summer. The Pastoral Committee has also arranged MAGIS Thailand and MAGIS Lantau in June and July respectively to provide cultural immersion and enhance personal development through exchange programs.

Despite the challenges posed by the pandemic, we have also seen some exciting developments in the use of technology in education. We have learned a great deal about how to make good use of online resources and technology to enhance learning and will continue to incorporate these advancements into our teaching practices. We launched BYOD in junior forms and continuously upgraded the IT infrastructure. With sponsorship from the Wah Yan One Family Foundation, all classrooms have installed interactive panels to enhance engagement, improve collaboration, and increase interactivity in the classroom learning atmosphere.

Another exciting development is the establishment of the Wah Yan Heritage Centre, which soft opened on December 17th, 2023, after years of hard work and preparation. The Centre aims to help the Wah Yan community celebrate our proud traditions and boyhood while also fostering connections for future generations.
