Topping Ceremony

A topping ceremony was held on 24 September 2004 to commemorate the completion of the structural works of Phases 1 & 2 of the School Development Project. Rev. Fr. A.J. Deignan officiated at the simple but memorable ceremony with SDP patrons Mr. William Kwan and Mr. Hugo Hung, co-chairman Dr. Patrick Wu, convener Mr. George Tam, Mr. Peter Tam, representatives of the school staff, the PSA, the PTA, student bodies, the architects and the contractors.

Phase 1 of the School Development Project (SDP) is the Government financed School Improvement Programme (SIP). Phase 2 is an extension of Phase 1 funded by donation money. Phase 3 is a school hall that will accommodate all the students of the school at one time and be large enough for a full size indoor basketball court with a spectators' stand. It will also contain five extra classrooms that will help to make the 'through-train' education mode possible and a lecture theatre of decent size.

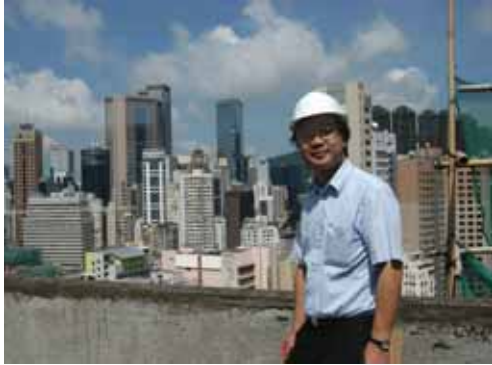

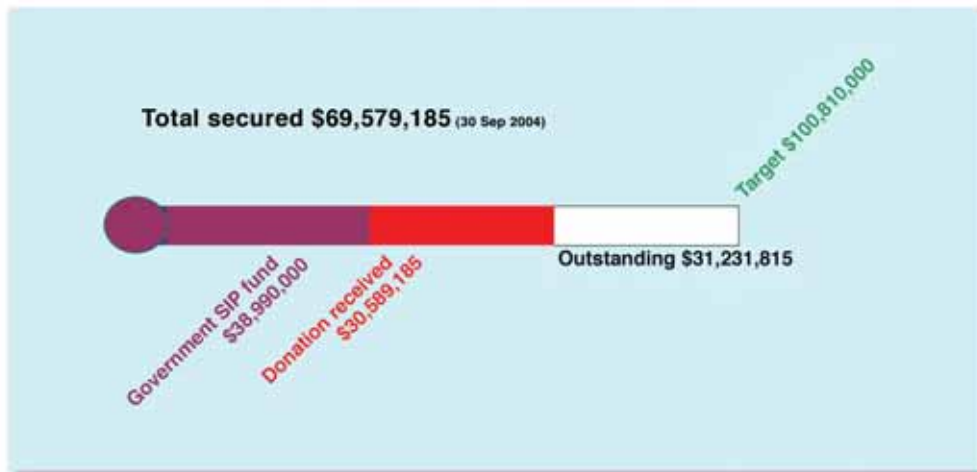
